Christos is a Senior Consultant Gynaecologist, Fertility Specialist, and Assistant Professor at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece, as well as a Visiting Senior Research Fellow at the University of New South Wales, Australia. He is the Global Head of Clinical Research for Virtus Health, a leading global provider of ART services.

With over \$1.5 million in research funding secured in the past five years, Prof. Venetis is among the top 1% of cited researchers in Obstetrics and Reproductive Medicine (2021). He has authored more than 115 publications (h-index: 42, 7,800+ citations), co-edited a textbook on Recurrent Implantation Failure, and spoken at over 200 international conferences.

A strong advocate for evidence-based medicine, he has served on the Human Reproduction editorial board since 2008 and holds editorial roles with RBM Online, Reproductive Biology & Endocrinology, F&S Reviews, Reproductive Sciences, and Fertility & Reproduction.

Prof. Venetis coordinates MSc programs in Human Reproduction and Reproductive Medicine at Aristotle University and the University of New South Wales, respectively. His research focuses on ovarian stimulation, endometrial receptivity, reproductive epidemiology, and the health of mothers and babies after ART. He also mentors junior colleagues and has held leadership roles with the Fertility Society of Australia and New Zealand and RANZCOG.
